#### Food and Water ==



Keep 3-7 days worth of food in an airtight, waterproof container, and have a water bowl to use.

#### First-Aid Kit



Include items appropriate for your pets medical needs, and additional supplements they take daily.

#### Collar with ID Tags



Have printed copies of your pet's registration information on hand and available electronically.

#### Familiar Items



Include familiar items such as beds, toys, treats, and bones to relieve your pet's stress.

# Pet Kennel $\stackrel{ ext{def}}{=}$



Familiarize your pet with the carrier so they are comfortable, and practice your evacuation plan with the kennel.

#### Photos of Your Pet o



Include photos of your pet in case they get separated during an emergency.

### Microchipping G



Microchipping ensures your pet can be found if they get lost during a disasters.

## Develop a Buddy 🖏 **System**



In case you cannot take care of your pet while evacuating, ensure friends or neighbors are available to care for them.

## Bring Pets Indoors



Always bring pets indoors before severe weather or a disaster.
